Soil and groundwater investigations were conducted at the above-referenced site and a release of petroleum hydrocarbons was documented. North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) staff propose that no further work be required. The purpose of this notice is to inform interested parties, including owners of nearby land, that the case is being considered for closure, and to invite public comments on this proposed decision.

Problem Description

This site is the location of a former bulk fuel terminal facility that was operated from about 1937 to 1983, when the fuel storage equipment and facilities were removed. Site assessment activities were conducted since 2005 with the primary contaminants of concern (COCs) being total petroleum hydrocarbons as gasoline, diesel, kerosene, and motor oil. Though the COC releases were related to above-ground storage tanks (ASTs), the unauthorized releases consist entirely of petroleum hydrocarbon-related compounds and are similar to those from underground storage tank (UST) sites.

Proposed Action

Case closure is proposed. This site meets the conditions for closure under the State Water Resources Control Board's "<u>Low-Threat Underground Storage Tank Case</u> Closure Policy"
