A release of petroleum hydrocarbons was documented and soil and groundwater investigations were conducted at the above-referenced site. Although some contamination remains, this site meets the conditions for closure under the State Water Resources Control Board's "Low-Threat Underground Storage Tank Case Closure Policy." Regional Water Board staff proposes that no further work be required. The purpose of this notice is to inform interested parties, including owners of nearby land, that the case is being considered for closure, and to invite public comment on this proposed decision.

### **Problem Description**

One 400-gallon underground storage tank (UST) was removed from this rural ranch property in the early 1980s. Approximately 350 cubic yards of petroleum hydrocarbon contaminated soil was over-excavated in October 2021 from the location of the former UST. Groundwater sampling results from grab groundwater borings, the site's monitoring wells, and from the onsite (inoperable) domestic well further show that the contaminated groundwater plume is limited in extent.

### **Proposed Action**

Case closure is proposed. This site meets the conditions for closure under the State Water Resources Control Board's "<u>Low-Threat Underground Storage Tank Case</u> <u>Closure Policy</u>" available on the internet at
