## **Notice of Proposed No Further Action**

A soil and groundwater investigation was conducted at the above-referenced site to evaluate a release of petroleum hydrocarbons from a former heating oil underground storage tank (UST). Results from the investigation meet the conditions for closure under the State Water Resources Control Board's "Low-Threat Underground Storage Tank Case Closure Policy." Regional Water Board staff proposes that no further work be required. The purpose of this notice is to inform interested parties, including owners of nearby land, that the case is being considered for closure, and to invite public comment on this proposed decision.

## **Problem Description**

In June 1990, an unauthorized release was discovered during removal of a 250-gallon heating oil UST. A groundwater sample collected from the unpurged UST excavation pit indicated the release of total petroleum hydrocarbons as diesel (TPHd), toluene, ethylbenzene, and xylenes. Soil and groundwater samples collected during a February 2025 investigation reported all tested constituents in soil and groundwater samples below laboratory reporting limits; therefore, the site meets the Low-Threat Case Closure Policy. No water supply wells were impacted by this contamination.

## **Proposed Action**

Case closure is proposed. This site meets the conditions for closure under the State Water Resources Control Board's "<u>Low-Threat Underground Storage Tank Case Closure Policy</u>" (available on the internet at
