Soil and groundwater removal actions were conducted in response to releases of pentachlorophenol (PCP) at this former wood preserving facility. Although some contamination remains, this site meets the conditions for closure under the State Water Resources Control Board's Resolution 92-49. North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) staff propose that no further work be required. The purpose of this notice is to inform interested parties, including owners of nearby land, that the case is being considered for closure, and to invite public comments on this proposed decision.

Problem Description

This site is a former wood preserving facility that utilized oil-based PCP and water-based chromated-copper-arsenate preservatives. The facility was in operation from the 1960s through 1975 and was dismantled by Masonite in 1976, with cleanup activities initiated under a closure plan approved by the California Department of Health Services (DHS). Environmental investigation, remedial actions, and monitoring have been conducted primarily due to PCP impacts in shallow and deeper fractured groundwater. In addition, a Land Use Covenant (LUC) restricting soil and groundwater use at burdened areas of the site was recorded with the Sonoma County Recorder's office to address residual contamination in these burdened areas of the site.

Proposed Action

Case closure is proposed as the site has been fully assessed and remediated to the extent practicable and current site conditions pose little risk to human health or environment.

Unless significant comments are received or new information is presented regarding this site, Regional Water Board staff plans to proceed with the closure process upon
