## **Notice of Proposed No Further Action**

A soil and groundwater investigation was conducted at the above-referenced site and a release of contaminants was documented. Although some contamination remains, exposure will be controlled through a land use covenant. North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) staff proposes that no further work be required. The purpose of this notice is to inform interested parties, including owners of nearby land, that the case is being considered for closure, and to invite public comment on this proposed decision.

## **Problem Description**

Investigations were performed to look for impacts from site activities, which include power generation using steam from geothermal wells used to drive turbines to produce electricity. The investigations tested for petroleum, metals, polychlorinated biphenyls, and volatile organic compounds and some groundwater impacts were found. Limited groundwater impacts remain, but do not pose a significant threat to human health or the environment.

## **Proposed Action**

Case closure is proposed, with a land use covenant to preclude groundwater use for human consumption. Unless significant comments are received or new information is presented regarding this site, Regional Water Board staff plans to proceed with the closure process upon conclusion of the comment period.
