



Community Meeting for the Gualala Roads Assessment Order

Thursday, June 18, 2026 | 10 am - 12 pm

All interested community members are invited to attend a community meeting for the Gualala Roads Assessment Order. This order is being developed by the North Coast Water Board and will require the inventory, assessment, and prioritization of sediment-generating rural roads in the Gualala River Watershed. This will be one of two orders designed to improve road conditions, control excess sediment, and reduce elevated water temperatures. All of these reduce water quality and negatively impact the river's ecosystem, particularly its native salmon and trout populations.

This meeting will address the upcoming public review process, land access agreements, and an update on technical report preparation.

Sonoma Resource Conservation District (RCD) staff will be in attendance to connect with landowners and land managers in navigating this new water quality assessment order and provide on-the-ground technical assistance. The RCD provides non-regulatory, free assistance to our community.
