Gualala River TMDL Action Plan Development July 2024 Update

Third Quarter 2024 Update:

The public comment period for comments pertaining to CEQA is now closed. Comments submitted will be reviewed by Regional Board sta and will be available to the public as part of the environmental documentation package. Regional Board sta are in the early stages of developing an Order, or Orders, that will require the inventory, assessment, and prioritization of the treatment of roads to control sources of sediment. These orders will be a part of the implementation strategy for the TMDL. Information regarding the Orders will be provided through this email distribution list as it becomes available.

While the final California State budget has yet to be provided, it continues to appear as if the Budget Change Proposal from the Regional Board has been approved. If it remains unchanged from the 2024 May Revise, the proposal provides three new sta and \$1 million a year for five years to complete the Basin Planning Amendment, Order development, and subsequent implementation actions. The Region will be actively hiring these sta in the coming months alongside continued work on the Basin Plan amendment and implementing Orders.
