NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

PROPOSED APPROVAL OF AMENDMENTS TO THE WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN FOR THE CENTRAL COASTAL BASIN TO INCORPORATE APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF STATEWIDE PLANS AND POLICIES

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) will accept written comments on the Central Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board's (Central Coast Water Board's) amendments to the Water Quality Control Plan for the Central Coastal Basin (Basin Plan) to incorporate applicable provisions of statewide plans and policies, correct typographical errors and punctuation, and comply with web accessibility requirements in Government Code sections 7405 and 11135. The Basin Plan amendments make non-regulatory revisions (i.e., without regulatory effect under California Code of Regulations (CCR), title 1, section100, subdivision(a)) to the Basin Plan to improve and clarify its application and implementation to protect water quality.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMITTING WRITTEN COMMENTS

Persons interested in providing written comments on the Basin Plan amendments are encouraged to submit comments electronically. Comment letters must be received by **12:00 noon on November 1, 2024**. Late comment letters will not be accepted unless the State Water Board determines otherwise.

REQUIRMENTS FOR SUBMITTING COMMENTS

In accordance with California Code of Regulations, title 23, section 3779, subdivision (f), the State Water Board may refuse to accept any comment that does not satisfy all of the following requirements:

- 1. Comments must specifically address the Basin Plan amendments adopted by the Central Coast Water Board.
- If the Central Coast Water Board previously responded to a similar or identical comment, the commenter must explain why and in what manner the commenter believes each of the responses provided by the Central Coast Water Board to each comment was inadequate or incorrect.
- The commenter must include either a statement that each of the comments
 was timely raised before the Central Coast Water Board, or an explanation of
 why the commenter was unable to raise the specific comment before the
 Central Coast Water Board.
