NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) will receive written public comments on the 2022-2023 draft determinations to approve mitigation measures for the Water Quality Control Policy on the Use of Coastal and Estuarine Waters for Power Plant Cooling (Once-Through Cooling or OTC Policy) for the eight power plants listed above. A separate draft determination is available for each power plant. Written public comments submitted within the public comment period will be considered prior to approval of the 2022 – 2023 draft determinations.

Persons interested in the draft determinations are encouraged to submit comments electronically. Comment letters must be received no later than **12:00 noon on March 21, 2025**, to be considered. Comment letters received after that deadline will not be accepted unless the State Water Board determines otherwise.

BACKGROUND

The State Water Board's OTC Policy requires owners and operators of existing power plants to implement measures to mitigate interim impingement and entrainment impacts to marine life resulting from their cooling water intake structures. The interim mitigation period commenced on October 1, 2015, and continues up to and until owners or operators achieve final compliance with the OTC Policy. Section 2.C(3) of the OTC Policy provides information required to demonstrate compliance with the interim mitigation requirements. The owners and operators of the eight power plants listed above elected to comply with interim mitigation requirements by providing annual payments to the Ocean Protection Council and State Coastal Conservancy for appropriate projects. The 2022-2023 draft determinations are based on entrainment and impingement impacts between October 1, 2022, and September 30, 2023.

State Water Board [Resolution No. 2015-0057](#) described the original procedures for calculating interim mitigation payments and approving mitigation measures. In 2024, the State Water Board adopted [Resolution No. 2024-0014](#), which revised the interim mitigation calculation to ensure that annual payments continue to appropriately compensate for interim impacts to marine life based on current mitigation costs. In accordance with Resolution No. 2024-0014, the State Water Board prepared annual draft determinations calculating interim mitigation payments and is accepting written comments.
