## **Project Description:**

The purpose of this project is to resolve Notices of Violation issued by CDFW and the County of Santa Barbara Planning and Development Department for unpermitted installation of a 100-footlong culvert in a watercourse, unpermitted grading, and unpermitted vegetation removal.

The proposed project activities include:

- Removing 52 feet of a 24-inch high-density polyethylene culvert and associated fill dirt;
- Building sandstone boulder headwalls at the ends of the remaining 48-foot-long culvert section; and
- Placing an ungrouted rip-rap energy dissipater at the culvert outlet.

## Mitigation activites include:

- Permittee responsible enhancement of 0.02 acres of riparian habitat; and
- Permittee responsible rehabilitation of 0.21 acres of riparian habitat.
