### **Project Description:**

The purpose of the project is to maintain and improve the quality of natural resources at Laguna Grande Regional Park through the preservation and protection of existing habitats, removal of invasive vegetation, and the mitigation of habitat disturbance.

The proposed project activities include:

- Reducing absolute cover of non-native invasive plant species to less than 20 percent;
- Increasing absolute cover of native plant species to 80 percent; and
- Replacing sections of trails impacted by root damage or erosion.

No mitigation is proposed.
