On October 22, 2014, this Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Regional Board Order No. R4-2014-0187, which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In the letter dated February 28, 2017, you requested termination of the WDR coverage under Regional Board Order No. R4-2014-0187 because injection of sodium persulfate was completed in April 2015 and no additional injection activities are planned in the future. Therefore, the WDR is no longer needed. The coverage under Regional Board Order No. R4-2014-0187 for the subject site is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement under the term of the permit.
