
Dear Ms. King:

On October 19, 2015, the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) informed you that the dewatering activities associated with the Arroyo Sequit Steelhead and Stream Restoration Project are regulated under Regional Board Order No. 93-010, which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In the letter dated November 15, 2016, you requested the termination of the WDR coverage under Regional Board Order No. 93-010 because the wastewater generated from the dewatering activities was never discharged to land. The coverage under Regional Board Order No. 93-010 for the subject site is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement under the term of the permit.
