TYPOGRAPHICAL CORRECTION, WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT - CITY OF SIMI VALLEY WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLANT (NPDES NO. CA0055221, CI NO. 3021)

The Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Water Board) staff has completed our review of your letter dated January 30, 2012, requesting that the Regional Water Board correct the selenium effluent limitation. You stated in your letter that it appears a number was accidentally selected from the wrong column in the spreadsheet, resulting in incorrect selenium limits being included in the 2003 NPDES permit. The City requests that the selenium limits be modified to reflect the correct effluent limit calculations according to the *Policy for Implementation of Toxics Standards for Inland Surface Waters, Enclosed Bays, and Estuaries of California* (SIP) procedures. Regional Water Board staff completed the review and agrees that it was a typographical error and has made the correction. In addition, the reasonable potential analysis (RPA) table has been corrected (see attached). The corrected selenium effluent limitations are presented below:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Order No. R4-2003-0081 (as Revised by Order No. R4-2004-0121), adopted by this Regional Water Board on June 5, 2003, and August 5, 2004, respectively, is hereby amended as follows (additions are underlined, deletions are lined through):

1. Waste Discharge Requirements section I.A.2.(b) page 28, shall read as follows:
