WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS AND WATER RECYCLING REQUIREMENTS FOR LIMONEIRA COMPANY, 1141 CUMMINGS ROAD, SANTA PAULA, CALIFORNIA (File No. 66-066, CI-5322)

Our letter of August 15, 2002, transmitted revised tentative Waste Discharge Requirements and Water Recycling Requirements (WDRs/WRRs) including Monitoring and Reporting Program, for Limoneira Company.

Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, this Regional Board at a public meeting held on August 29, 2002, reviewed the revised tentative Waste Discharge Requirements and Water Recycling Requirements, considered all factors in the case, and adopted WDRs/WRRs Order No. R4-2002-0139 (copy enclosed) relative to this discharge. Standard Provisions, which are a part of the WDRs/WRRs, are also enclosed.

Please note that the tentative Orders for Limoneira Company, as previously sent in the Regional Board's letter of August 15, 2002, have been revised per the attached Change Sheet.

You are required to implement the new Monitoring and Reporting Program No. CI-5322 on the effective date of Order No. R4-2002-0139. Your first monitoring report under these Requirements is due to this Regional Board by October 15, 2002. All monitoring reports should be sent to the Regional Board, Attn: Information Technology Unit.

Please reference all monitoring reports to our Compliance File No. CI-5322. We would appreciate if you would not combine other reports, such as progress or technical reports, with your monitoring reports.

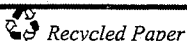
