CORRECTION TO WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT - DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVY, SAN CLEMENTE ISLAND WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT (WWTP) (ORDER NO. R4-2013-0111, NPDES NO. CA0110175, CI NO. 6432)

The staff of Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board) has determined that a minor revision of the Monitoring and Reporting Program (MRP) language for the San Clemente Island WWTP permit (NPDES No. CA0110175, Order No. R4-2013-0111) is necessary for clarification. This minor revision does not require public notice or opportunity to comment. Section IV Effluent Monitoring Requirements (page E-10) is revised as follows:

The discharger shall monitor secondary and/or tertiary effluent at EFF-01 as follows in Table 3.

The Regional Water Board hereby modifies the language in section IV of the MRP as presented above.
