TYPOGRAPHICAL CORRECTION, MONITORING AND REPORTING PROGRAM (MRP) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – UNITED STATES NAVY, NAVAL AUXILIARY LANDING FIELD, SAN CLEMENTE ISLAND WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT (NPDES NO. CA0110175, CI NO. 6432)

The Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Water Board) staff discussed the timeline specified in the 2013 NPDES permit for the *Outfall Inspection Report* with staff of the United States Navy. The permit indicates that the inspection is to be completed in July or August and the final report is to be submitted by April 15. The permit also states that the first report is to be due on April 15, 2014; however, the permit did not become effective until August 30, 2013. The permit was not issued in time to complete the inspection in the specified time frame in 2013. The Regional Water Board has completed our review of the timeline specified in the 2013 NPDES permit regarding the *Outfall Inspection Report* and agrees that it was a typographical error and has made the correction.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Order No. R4-2013-0111, adopted by this Regional Water Board on August 30, 2013, is hereby amended as follows:

Monitoring and Reporting Program section X.D.4. on page E-34 shall read as follows:

A summary of the Outfall Inspection Report findings shall be submitted by April 15 of the year following an outfall inspection survey. This written report, augmented with videographic and/or photographic images, will provide a description of the observed external condition of the discharge pipes from shallow water to their respective termini. The first report is due **April 15**, **2015**.
