**RESPONSE TO YOUR REQUEST FOR TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER INDIVIDUAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) FOR CALIFORNIA SULPHUR COMPANY, WILMINGTON, CA. (ORDER NO. R4-2014-0059; NPDES NO. CA0059064, CI NO. 6546)**

Thank you for your letter dated June 27, 2014, requesting termination of your NPDES permit. The letter indicated that California Sulphur Company (Facility) has not discharged to surface water since 1994. The Facility has a storm water retention system rated to hold a 100 year storm event. Since the discharge is storm water only, the Facility will be filing a Notice of Intent (NOI) in the near future to be enrolled in the General NPDES permit for Stormwater Discharges Associated with Industrial Activity (Industrial General Permit).

The request for termination of your individual NPDES permit is under review. In the interim, all conditions, requirements and provisions contained in your NPDES permit (Order No. R4-2014-0059), including submittal of monitoring reports, remain in full force and effect.
