**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:**

The California State Department of Parks and Recreation, a public agency, operates Topanga State Park at 20825 Entrada Road, Topanga, California. Topanga State Park is located at the southeastern portion of the Santa Monica Mountains.

Topanga State Park is currently discharging their wastewater under File No. 81-22, Order No. 87-88, CI-6583 adopted by this Regional Board on June 22, 1987. The estimated yearly average discharge is less than 2,000 gallons per day of domestic wastewater to 3 septic tank/leach field systems from the comfort stations and 1 septic tank/leach field system from a trailhead located at the Yoba (Trippet Ranch) and Upper Topanga areas. The capacity of the septic tank at the Main Lot is 4,000 gallons. There are four seepage pits at this location. Each pit is 30 feet deep and 5 feet in diameter.

The Yoba area is located about 3.7 miles north of Pacific Coast Highway and 0.8 miles east of Topanga Canyon Boulevard. The capacity of the septic tank at this location is 750 gallons. The leach field area is 20 ft. X 60 ft. The Upper Topanga area is located about 4.4 miles north of Pacific Coast Highway and 0.5 miles east of Topanga Canyon Boulevard.

**VOLUME AND DESCRIPTION OF DISCHARGE:**

The Discharger discharges less than 2,000 gallons per day of treated domestic wastewater from the subject site (Latitude: 34°05'36", Longitude: 118°35'16"). The wastewater is composed of domestic wastewater and shall be treated and disposed of using the septic tank/leach field systems.
