**WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – CONOCOPHILLIPS COMPANY, CONOCOPHILLIPS LOS ANGELES LUBRICANTS TERMINAL (NPDES PERMIT NO. CA0059846, CI-6773)**

Our letter dated January 21, 2010, transmitted the revised tentative waste discharge requirements for renewal of your permit to discharge wastes under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Program.

Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, this Regional Board at a public hearing held on February 4, 2010, reviewed the revised tentative requirements, considered all comments received, and adopted Order R4-2010-0019 (copy enclosed). This Order serves as your NPDES permit and expires on January 10, 2015. Section 13376 of the California Water Code requires that an application and Report of Waste Discharge for a new permit must be filed at least 180 days before the expiration date.

You are required to implement the Monitoring and Reporting Program (MRP) on the effective date (March 6, 2010) of the permit. The dates that the monitoring and annual reports must be received at the Regional Board Office are provided in the MRP. Submit all monitoring reports and annual reports to the Regional Board, Attn: Information Technology Unit. When submitting monitoring, technical reports, or any correspondence regarding the discharge under Order No. R4-2010-0019 to the Regional Board, please include a reference to our Compliance File No. **CI 6773** to assure that the reports are directed to the appropriate staff and file. Please do not combine your discharge monitoring reports with other reports. Submit each type of report as a separate document.

The complete adopted permit will be sent only to the Discharger. However, these documents are available on the Regional Board's website for your review. The Regional Board's web address is [www.waterboards.ca.gov/losangeles/](http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/losangeles/).


