ORDER NO. R4-2002-0092

RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS
FOR DISCHARGES TO LAND/GROUNDWATER

1. This Regional Board has adopted waste discharge requirements for the dischargers listed below.
2. These dischargers have either enrolled under a general Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs), or terminated their waste discharge, or have not had any discharge from their facilities since issuance of the waste discharge requirements.
3. Board staff has verified, by inspection, that these facilities have discharged wastewater under the general WDRs, or discontinued discharging, or there is no waste discharged.
4. The Board finds that these requirements are no longer applicable and should be rescinded.
5. The Board has transmitted copies of this tentative Order to the dischargers and to interested agencies and persons, and has notified them of its intent to rescind requirements at a public meeting to be held on April 25, 2002.
6. At that public meeting, the Board gave the opportunity for a hearing and considered comments and correspondence pertaining to this matter.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following requirements be rescinded:
