TERMINATION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (WDRs) AND NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT FOR CITY OF SANTA CLARITA — DRAINAGE BENEFIT ASSESSMENT AREAS NO. 6 AND NO. 18, CANYON COUNTRY (NPDES PERMIT NO. CA0061638, CI-6945)

Our letter dated February 10, 2012, transmitted a copy of the tentative Order which would terminate the waste discharge requirements and NPDES permit for the groundwater dewatering systems at Drainage Benefit Assessment Areas No. 6 and No. 18 (Pump Stations No. 1 – Nathan Hill and No. 2 – Bakerton).

Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, the Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Water Board), at a public hearing held on April 5, 2012, reviewed the tentative Order, considered all factors in the case, and adopted Order No. R4-2012-0072 (copy enclosed) relative to the termination of Order Nos. R4-2003-0099 and R4-2007-0016.

Should any future activities at the subject site result in discharges of wastewater to surface waters, you are required to file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Regional Water Board prior to discharge.
