SOUTH GARFIELD AVE., LOS ANGELES, CA. (NPDES NO. CA0062022, CI NO. 6984)**


Our letter dated March 25, 2008, enclosed a copy of a tentative Order which would rescind the subject requirements and NPDES permit.

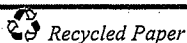

ORDER No. R4-2008-0026

RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS
AND
NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT
FOR DISCHARGES IN THE LOS ANGELES REGION

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region, finds:

1. This Regional Board adopted waste discharge requirements for discharges to surface waters which also serve as a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for Dischargers listed below.
2. The Dischargers have been enrolled under a general NPDES permit or have eliminated its wastewater discharges to surface waters.
3. Therefore, the following waste discharge requirements and NPDES permits are no longer necessary and should be rescinded.
4. The following Orders are hereby rescinded, except for enforcement purposes.
5. The rescission of waste discharge requirements is exempt from the provisions of Chapter 3 (commencing with Section 21100), Division 13, Public Resources Code, in accordance with Water Code Section 13389.

The Regional Board has notified the Dischargers and interested agencies and persons of its intent to consider rescission of the following waste discharge requirements and has provided them with an opportunity to submit their written views and recommendations.


The Regional Board, in a public hearing, heard and considered all comments and testimony pertinent to the matter.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following waste discharge requirements and NPDES permits be rescinded:

Sahm Broadway Property, LLC (Former Elixir Industries) 18037 South Broadway St. Gardena, CA (CA0062537)	R4-2003-0149 (December 4, 2003)	Ceased discharge of groundwater to surface water.
The Dial Corp. 5832 S. Garfield Avenue Los Angeles, CA (CA0062022)	R4-2004-0141 (September 2, 2004)	Storm water from blending operation area is discharged to sanitary sewer.
Home Depot, U.S.A., Inc. (Former ITT Aerospace Controls) 1200 South Flower Street Burbank, CA (CA0064467)	R4-2002-0185 (December 12, 2002)	Treated groundwater discharged to sanitary sewer.
