**TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – K-G PROPERTIES, 157 SOUTH FAIRFAX AVENUE, LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994001, CI-7075)**

The subject discharge is regulated under Order No. 97-045, *General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit and Waste Discharge Requirements for Groundwater Discharges from Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

Your letter dated November 8, 2002, informed the Board that there has never been any discharge of groundwater to surface waters since the NPDES Permit was issued on March 20, 1992. Accordingly, you requested termination of coverage under NPDES permit number CAG994001 for the subject facility.

On November 12, 2002, Board Staff inspected the facility and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater to the storm drain. Since there is no discharge from the site, coverage under Board Order No. 97-045 for the subject facility is hereby rescinded.

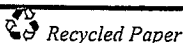

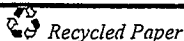
