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**CONTINUATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT
DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT CAG994001; ORDER NO. 97-045. GW-
K-G Properties, 157 S. Fairfax Ave., Los Angeles [EXISTING CAG994001; CI 7075]**

Your facility is currently enrolled under General Permit No. CAG994001, Order No. 91-092, adopted by this Regional Board pursuant to the Federal Clean Water Act and the California Water Code. That NPDES permit expired on July 10, 1996, but your discharge requirements remained in full force and effect pending Regional Board action on the general permit reissuance.

This Regional Board, at a public hearing on May 12, 1997, adopted Order No. 97-045 replacing Order 91-092. Based on our review of your facility's information, we have determined that your facility meets the conditions to be regulated under Order No. 97-045 (General NPDES Permit). Enclosed is a copy of the permit and your new monitoring program. To continue coverage under the General NPDES Permit, you must complete the enclosed Notice of Intent (NOI) to comply with the waste discharge requirements contained in Order No. 97-045 and return the completed NOI by August 15, 1997. If we do not receive the completed NOI by that date, your coverage is terminated and you will be discharging without a permit which is a violation of the Federal Clean Water Act and the California Water Code.

Please note that your NPDES permit number (CAG994001) and Monitoring and Reporting Program number (CI 7075) remain the same. All monitoring reports should be sent to the Regional Board, Attn: Data and Information Management Unit. Please reference all technical and monitoring reports to our Compliance File No. CI 7075. Submit each type of report as a separate document (do not combine with other reports).

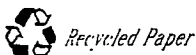
