TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – WALT DISNEY PICTURES AND TELEVISION, 500 SOUTH BUENA VISTA STREET, BURBANK, CALIFORNIA (CAG994003, CI-7238)

In our letter dated October 20, 1997, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Board Order No. 98-055, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

Your letter of April 17, 2000 informed the Regional Board that Walt Disney Pictures and Television has ceased discharging cooling tower bleed off to the storm drain, and has diverted the bleed off to the City of Burbank sanitary sewer system. Therefore, you requested termination of coverage under NPDES permit number CAG994003 for the subject facility.

Board staff inspected the facility on March 2, 2000 and verified that there is no discharge of wastes from the cooling tower bleed off to the storm drain. Since there is no discharge to any storm drain, coverage under Board Order No. 98-055 for the subject facility is hereby terminated.
