TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT— KINDER MORGAN, 2200 JOHN S. GIBSON BLVD., SAN PEDRO, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG674001, CI-7332)

The subject discharge is regulated under Order No. Order No. R4-2004-0109, General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of low threat hydrostatic test water to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, adopted by this Board on July 1, 2004.

We have reviewed your October 23, 2007, letter which requested termination of your coverage under the General NPDES Permit. The letter indicated that you do not anticipate discharges requiring coverage under this permit.

On December 20, 2007, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge from the site to the Pacific Ocean. Since there is no discharge of hydrostatic test water from the facility, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2004-0109, General NPDES Permit No. CAG674001, for the facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.
