TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS—CENTURY SPORTS CLUB & DAY SPA, 4120 W. OLYMPIC BOULEVARD, LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG834001, CI-7389)


Dear Mr. Kim:

In our letter dated June 30, 1997, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. 97-046, *General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit and Waste Discharge Requirements for Treated Groundwater and Other Wastewaters from Investigation and/or Cleanup of Petroleum Fuel Pollution to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*. Order No. 97-046 has been replaced by Order No. R4-2003-0111, General NPDES No. CAG994004.

We have reviewed our files and found that discharge of treated groundwater has been terminated at the above-referenced facility since 1997. We understand that the treatment system is no longer operational. Therefore, the coverage under General NPDES permit is no longer necessary. On October 17, 2007, Regional Board staff inspected the facility and found that there is no discharge to surface waters from the site.

Since there is no discharge from the site, coverage under Board Order 97-046 for the subject facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes. Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this office and obtain Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) prior to discharging any groundwater from the site to surface waters.
