TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION, LENNOX COUNTY PARK, 10828 SOUTH CONDON AVENUE, LOS ANGELES (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-7532)

In our letter dated April 12, 2005, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0111, *General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharge of Groundwater From Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have received and reviewed your November 10, 2005, letter requesting termination of your coverage under the general NPDES permit, because the pool backwash wastewater discharge from the subject facility has been routed to the sanitary sewer system.

On November 22, 2005, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of backwash water from the site to the storm drain. Since there is no discharge of pool backwash water from the subject site, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0111, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004 for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of pool backwash water to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain waste discharge requirements.
