TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—DBA ULTIMATE, NON-CONTACT COOLING WATER DISCHARGE, 3600 S. GRAND AVENUE, LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994003, CI—7679)


Discharge of non-contact cooling water generated from the above-referenced facility is currently regulated under NPDES General Permit No. CAG994003 (Order No. 98-055) adopted by this Board on June 29, 1998. The Order No. 98-055 has been replaced by Order No. R4-2003-0058, General NPDES No. CAG994003.

You have informed the Regional Board that the facility building has been demolished and non-contact cooling water discharge no longer occurs at the facility. On October 18, 2007, staff inspected the facility and verified that there is no discharge to the storm drain.

Since there is no discharge from the site to the storm drain, coverage under Board Order No. 98-055 for the subject facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes. Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface water becomes necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this office and obtain a Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) prior to discharging any groundwater from the site to surface waters.

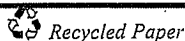
