RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS – Headworks Well Replacement and Development Project (Order No. 99-090; CI 8076; File No. 99-112)

Our letter dated August 28, 2001, transmitted a copy of the tentative order for the rescission of the subject requirements because the development of Headworks Wells has been completed and the discharge to Headworks Spreading Grounds has been terminated.

Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, this Regional Board at a public hearing held on September 19, 2001, reviewed the tentative order and considered all factors in the case and adopted Order No. 01-134 relative to the rescission. A copy of this Order is herein attached.

Should any future activities at the subject site result in any discharge of waste, you are required to file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Regional Board at least 120 days prior to discharge.

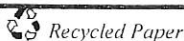

ORDER NO. 01-134

RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS
FOR DISCHARGES TO LAND/GROUNDWATER

1. This Regional Board has adopted waste discharge requirements for the dischargers listed below.
2. These dischargers have since terminated their waste discharge or have not had any discharge from their facility since issuance of the waste discharge requirements.
3. Board staff has verified, by inspection, that this facility has discontinued discharging or there is no waste being discharged.
4. The Board finds that these requirements are no longer applicable and should be rescinded.
5. The Board has transmitted copies of this tentative Order to the dischargers and to interested agencies and persons, and has notified them of its intent to rescind requirements at a public meeting to be held on September 19, 2001.
6. At that public meeting, the Board gave the opportunity for a hearing and considered comments and correspondence pertaining to this matter.


