TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS—CALCLEAN INC., GARDENA UST SITE, 1344 W. REDONDO BEACH BLVD., GARDENA, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG834001, CI-8388)


In our letter dated July 11, 2002, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2002-0125, *General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System and Waste Discharge Requirements for Treated Groundwater and Other Wastewaters from Investigation and/or Cleanup of Petroleum Fuel-Contaminated Sites to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

In a fax letter to staff dated October 16, 2007, you requested termination of the subject permit because your groundwater extraction and treatment system has been removed from the site. An inspection conducted by staff from this office on October 26, 2007, found that there is no discharge of groundwater at the site to surface waters.

Since you have ceased the discharge of groundwater to surface waters at the site, an NPDES permit is not necessary and coverage under Board Order No. R4-2002-0125 for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

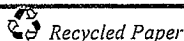
Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this office and obtain appropriate Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) prior to discharging any groundwater from the site to surface waters.
