REVISED GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS—CALLEGUAS WATER DISTRICT—EXTENDED PHASE 1 BRINE LINE PROJECT, ALONG HUENEME ROAD TO LEWIS ROAD (OLD) AND TO CAMROSA WATER RECYCLING FACILITY IN AN UNINCORPORATED AREA OF VENTURA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-8400)

In our letter dated October 17, 2006, we authorized the discharge of groundwater from the above-referenced project under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) General Permit No. CAG994004, Order No. R4-2003-0111; *General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater From Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003.

We have completed our review of your June 8, 2007, request to revise the coverage for the above-referenced project under General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004, CI-8400. The revision is necessary to incorporate the proposed extension of your construction project from Hueneme Road to Lewis Road (Old), and the access road to Camrosa Water Recycling Facility (CWRf) under the coverage of the General NPDES permit.

Based on the information provided, we have no objections to incorporating the proposed extension of your construction project under your enrollment for the above-referenced NPDES permit. Enclosed are your Waste Discharge Requirements, which also serve as your NPDES permit, consisting of Order R4-2003-0111, revised Fact Sheet, and Monitoring & Reporting Program No. CI-8400. The discharge limitations in Part E.1.a. and 1.b. of Order No. R4-2003-0111 for the specific constituents listed on the Table with the enclosed Fact Sheet are applicable to your discharge. The groundwater is discharged to three different Outfalls; Outfall No.1 flows into Calleguas Creek below Potrero Road; Outfall No.2 flows into the Revolon Slough, thence to Calleguas Creek, below Potrero Road; and Outfall No.3 flows into Mugu Drain. Therefore, the discharge limitations listed in Attachment B of Order No. R4-2003-0111 are not applicable to your discharge.

The Monitoring and Reporting Program requires you to implement the monitoring program on the effective date of coverage under this permit. All monitoring reports should be sent to the Regional Board, ATTN: Information Technology Unit. When submitting monitoring or technical reports to the Regional Board per these requirements, please include a reference to "Compliance File No.
