TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – CALLEGUAS MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT, LAS POSAS FEEDER UNIT 3 PROJECT, MOORPARK, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-8438)

In our letter dated November 21, 2003, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0111, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater From Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have reviewed your November 7, 2005 letter which requested termination of coverage under the General Permit. The letter indicated that you have completed the above-referenced construction project and have ceased discharging groundwater from the subject facility to the Arroyo Simi.

On February 27, 2006, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the site to the Arroyo Simi. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the subject site, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0111, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004, for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain waste discharge requirements.
