

Dear Mr. Larson:

Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) staff received the November 28, 2005 notification from your environmental consultant (Enviro Forensic Investigations, Incorporated) that all activities to be conducted under General Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R4-2002-0030, Series No. 009, No. CI-8478, were completed as of issuance of the May 2005, *Enhanced Bioremediation Pilot Study Monitoring Report (April 2004 – September 2004), Former Pneumo Abex Facility, Oxnard, California*. The notification requested termination of the enrollment under General Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R4-2002-0030, Series No. 009, No. CI-8478.

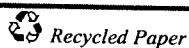
