REQUIREMENTS – HOLLYWOOD STREET MAINTENANCE YARD, 6640 ROMAINE
STREET, LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA (ORDER NO. R4-2002-0030, SERIES NO. 010, CI-
8484)**

Dear Mr. Mulhern:

In our letter dated September 26, 2002, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2002-0030, (Series No. 010), which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In a letter dated February 22, 2010, you notified the Regional Board that you ceased oxygen release compound injection for the site and that you requested termination of the WDR.

The monitoring results were provided to the Regional Board in quarterly monitoring reports. Since you have completed the in-situ remediation and no longer need the WDR, the coverage under Board Order No. R4-2002-0030, (Series No. 010), for the subject facility is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement under the term of the permit.
