TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR SPECIFIED DISCHARGES TO GROUNDWATER IN SANTA CLARA AND LOS ANGELES RIVER BASINS – VALENCIA WATER COMPANY REPLACEMENT WELL U6, PM20838 NEAR SOLEDAD CANYON ROAD AND BENTGRASS WAY, SANTA CLARITA, CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. 03-100, CI-8617)

We have received a letter dated June 30, 2004, from your Assistant Operations Manager, Mr. Michael Alvord, requesting that we terminate your enrollment under the General Waste Discharge Requirements (Order No. 93-010), for discharge of water produced during the installation and development of water supply well U6 onto approximately 33 acres of vacant land near the interception of Soledad Canyon Road and Bentgrass Way in Santa Clarita, California. In the letter, Mr. Alvord indicated that the discharge ceased on March 5, 2004 and the project has been completed.
