TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—VENTURA COUNTY WATERSHED PROTECTION DISTRICT, ARUNDELL BARRANCA PROJECT, UPSTREAM OF HARBOR BOULEVARD, VENTURA, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-8633)

In our letter dated September 11, 2003, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0111, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater From Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have reviewed your June 29, 2007, letter requesting termination of coverage under the General NPDES Permit. The letter indicated that you have completed the Arundell Barranca Channel Improvement Project and groundwater discharge from the subject facility to the Ventura Coastal Stream has been ceased.

On September 24, 2007, Board staff inspected the facility and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the subject site to the Ventura Coastal Stream. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the subject site, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0111, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004 is hereby terminated, except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain waste discharge requirements.


