REVISION OF MONITORING AND REPORTING PROGRAM UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS – EATON CORPORATION, FORMER EATON FACILITY, 31717 LA TIENDA DRIVE, WESTLAKE VILLAGE, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-8640)

Thank you for your letter dated May 25, 2005, requesting modification of your Monitoring and Reporting Program for the above-referenced facility. In our letter dated January 8, 2004, we authorized you to discharge wastewater generated from the groundwater cleanup project under Order No. R4-2003-0111, *General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater from Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties* which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have reviewed the information you have provided. The analytical data indicate that you have consistently shown compliance with the permit's effluent limitation for pH, TDS, sulfate, chloride, nitrogen, boron, copper, nickel, settleable solids, sulfides, phenols, residual chlorine, and MBAS. Therefore, the monitoring frequency for these constituents has been reduced from monthly to quarterly. Enclosed is the revised Monitoring and Reporting Program No. CI-8640 that replaces your existing Monitoring and Reporting Program.

When submitting monitoring or technical reports to the Regional Board per these requirements, please include a reference to "Compliance File No. CI-8640 and NPDES No. CAG994004", which will assure that the reports are directed to the appropriate file and staff. Also, please do not combine other reports with your monitoring reports. Submit each type of report as a separate document. All monitoring reports should be sent to the Regional Board, ATTN: Information Technology Unit.
