**TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGE OF TREATED GROUNDWATER FROM A PETROLEUM HYDROCARBON FUEL AND/OR VOLATILE ORGANIC COMPOUND IMPACTED SITES – FORMER MOBILE SERVICE STATION 18-E45, 14206 MULBERRY DRIVE, CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. I-02988, CI-8660)**

Dear Mr. Puig and Mr. Lee:

We have received a letter dated February 7, 2005, from your Project Manager, Mr. Gene N. Ortega, requesting that we terminate your enrollment under the General Waste Discharge Requirements (Order No. R4-2002-0030), for discharge of treated groundwater through a passive-infiltration system. In the letter, Mr. Ortega indicated that no discharge of treated groundwater has taken place under the above referenced permit and the installation of the pump and treat module has been suspended due to changing site conditions and concurrence with the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board.

Since there has not been any discharge and you are not planning to discharge treated groundwater at the site, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2002-0030 for the facility is hereby terminated, effective February 7, 2005.
