**RESCISSION OF NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – DR HORTON LOS ANGELES HOLDING COMPANY, INC. (OLY MANDALAY BAY GENERAL PARTNERSHIP), (NPDES PERMIT NO. CA0064505, ORDER NO. R4-2003-0141, CI-8672)**

Dear Mr. Haub:

Our letter dated November 9, 2007, transmitted a copy of a tentative Order which would rescind the subject requirements and NPDES permit.

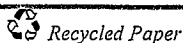

RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS  
AND  
NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT  
FOR DISCHARGES IN THE LOS ANGELES REGION

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region, finds:

1. This Regional Board adopted waste discharge requirements for discharges to surface waters which also serve as a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for the Discharger listed below.
2. The Discharger has been enrolled under an NPDES permit or have eliminated their wastewater discharges to surface waters.
3. Therefore, the following waste discharge requirements and NPDES permit is no longer necessary and should be rescinded.
4. The following Order is hereby rescinded, except for enforcement purposes.
5. The rescission of waste discharge requirements is exempt from the provisions of Chapter 3 (commencing with Section 21100), Division 13, Public Resources Code, in accordance with Water Code Section 13389.

The Regional Board has notified the Discharger and interested agencies and persons of their intent to consider rescission of the following waste discharge requirements and have provided them with an opportunity to submit their written views and recommendations.


The Regional Board, in a public hearing, heard and considered all comments and testimony pertinent to the matter.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following waste discharge requirements and NPDES permit be rescinded:

DR Horton Los Angeles Holding Company, Inc. (Oly Mandalay Bay General Partnership) (CA0064505)	R4-2003-0141 (November 6, 2003)	Treated groundwater, previously discharged to the Harbor Island Canal and the Edison Canal, a portion of Channel Islands Harbor, has been terminated.

The Executive Officer of this Regional Board, is authorized, and she is hereby directed, to certify and submit copies of this Order to the Discharger, and to such individuals and governmental agencies as may have need therefor, or may request same.
