TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – FRIENDLY VILLAGE MOBILE HOME PARK, 195 TIERRA REJADA ROAD, SIMI VALLEY, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-8719)

In our letter dated May 3, 2004, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0111, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater From Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have reviewed your November 21, 2006, letter requesting termination of your coverage under the General NPDES Permit. The letter indicated that the construction of flood control channel has been completed, and the associated dewatering wells has been abandoned and discharge has been ceased.

On June 1, 2007, Board staff inspected the facility and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the subject site to the Calleguas Creek. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the subject site, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0111, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004 is hereby terminated, except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain waste discharge requirements.


