**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ENVIRONMENTAL CHECKLIST AND ADOPTING A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION (RESOLUTION NO. R10-004) AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (ORDER NO. R04-2010-0088, CI-8724) FOR PILOT TESTS TO EVALUATE BIOAUGMENTATION OF VOLATILE ORGANIC COMPOUNDS (VOCS) IN GROUNDWATER AT FORMER NASA INDUSTRIAL PLANT, DOWNEY, CALIFORNIA (SCP NO. 032C) (FILE NO. 97-197 AND CI-8724)**

Dear Mr. Weaverling:

Our letter dated April 21, 2010, transmitted the tentative Resolution and Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for the subject site.

Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, this Regional Board at a public hearing held on June 3, 2010, reviewed the tentative resolution and WDRs, considered all factors in the case, and adopted the Resolution No. R10-004 and Order No. R4-2010-0088 (copies attached) relative to this waste discharge. Section 13263 (e) of the California Water Code provides that all Requirements shall be reviewed periodically and, upon such review, may be revised by the Regional Board.

Enclosed are the followings:

2. Board Order No. R4-2010-0088;
3. Monitoring and Reporting Program CI-8724; and
4. Standard Provisions Applicable to Waste Discharge Requirements.\*

The "Monitoring and Reporting Program" requires you to implement the monitoring program on the effective date of this Order. All monitoring reports should be sent to the Regional Board, ATTN: Information Technology Unit.

When submitting monitoring or technical reports to the Regional Board per these requirements, please include a reference to Compliance File CI-8724 and Order No. R4-2010-0088, which will assure that the reports, are directed to the appropriate file and staff. Please do not combine your discharge monitoring reports with other reports. Submit each type of report as a separate document.



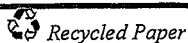
