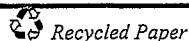
**TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – LOS ANGELES COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, FAIRPLEX STORM DRAIN PROJECT, 1101 W. MCKINLEY AVENUE, POMONA, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-8735)**

In our letter dated April 21, 2004, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0111, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater From Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have reviewed your March 6, 2006, letter requesting termination of your coverage under the General NPDES Permit. The letter indicated that the construction of Fairplex Storm Drain has been completed and groundwater discharge has been ceased. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the subject site, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0111, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004 is hereby terminated, except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain waste discharge requirements.
