TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS — HARRISON /ROBERTS ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT, FORMER SERVICE STATION, 7228 BEVERLY BOULEVARD, LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG834001, CI-8806)


In our letter dated July 6, 2007, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2007-0021, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Treated Groundwater and Other Wastewaters from Investigation and/or Cleanup of Petroleum Fuel-Contaminated Sites to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on April 5, 2007.

We have received and reviewed your June 20, 2008, letter requesting termination of your coverage under the General Permit. Your letter indicated that the groundwater treatment project and the accompanying dewatering activities at the above-referenced site have been completed:

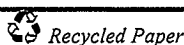
On September 24, 2008, Board staff inspected the site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the site to surface waters. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the site to surface waters, coverage under the Board Order No. R4-2007-0021, General NPDES Permit No. CAG834001, for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this office and obtain appropriate Waste Discharge Requirements prior to discharging any groundwater from the site to surface waters. 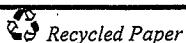
