TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – VENTURA COUNTY WATERSHED PROTECTION DISTRICT, ASSORTED VENTURA COUNTY EMERGENCY PROJECTS, VENTURA, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-8868)

In our letter dated February 17, 2005, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0111, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater From Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have reviewed your December 30, 2005, letter requesting termination of your coverage under the General NPDES Permit. The letter indicated that the emergency reconstruction of flood control structures has been completed and groundwater discharge has been ceased. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the subject sites, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0111, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004 is hereby terminated, except for enforcement purposes.

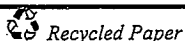
Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain waste discharge requirements.
