TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT – BEL AIR BAY CLUB, BEL AIR BAY CLUB IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, 16800 PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY, PACIFIC PALISADES CAG994004, CI-8889)

In our letter dated May 10, 2005, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0111, *General NPDES and Waste Discharge Requirements for Groundwater Discharges from Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

On January 17, 2006, you informed Regional Board staff that the above-referenced project was completed on September 14, 2005. Since the NPDES permit is no longer necessary, you requested termination of your coverage under the above-referenced General NPDES permit. On June 15, 2006, our staff inspected the facility and verified that there is no discharge to the storm drain.

Since there is no discharge from the site to the storm drain, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0111 for the subject facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes. If you have any questions, please contact Vilma Correa at (213) 576-6794.
