TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—SHAKMAN CONSTRUCTION, THE BEVERLY CONNECTION PROJECT, 100 N. LA CIENEGA BOULEVARD, LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-8936)


In our letter dated July 29, 2005, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0111, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater from Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

On June 5, 2008, the Regional Board adopted Order No. R4-2008-0032 which revised the subject General NPDES Permit. On June 12, 2008, the Regional Board sent you a Notice to Comply requesting submittal of Notice of Intent Form to re-enroll under Order No. R4-2008-0032.

Since we did not receive the Notice of Intent, on October 15, 2008 the Regional Board sent you a Notice of Violation notifying you of noncompliance with the waste discharge requirements established in Order R4-2003-0111, of violation of California Water Code §§13376 and 13383 by failing to submit a Notice of Intent or Report of Waste Discharge as required by Order R4-2003-0111, and of continuing to hold authorization and/or discharge under Order No. R4-2003-0111 without filing an NOI.

On May 29, 2009, staff inspected the subject project site and did not observe on-going construction project and dewatering activities at the site. Since there is no discharge from the site to surface waters, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0111 for the subject facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes. Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this office and obtain Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) prior to discharging any groundwater from the site to surface waters.
