TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—CITY OF LAKEWOOD, WATER RESOURCES DIVISION, ARBOR YARD WELL NO. 27, 5812 ARBOR ROAD, LAKEWOOD, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994005, CI—9005)


Dear Mr. Glancy:

In our letter dated December 20, 2005, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0108, *General NPDES and Waste Discharge Requirements for Groundwater Discharges from Potable Water Supply Wells to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

On August 23, 2010, you informed Regional Board staff that you ceased discharges from the above-referenced facility in June 2010. Since the NPDES permit is no longer necessary, you requested termination of your coverage under the above-referenced General NPDES permit. On December 15, 2010, staff inspected the facility and verified that there is no discharge to the storm drain.

Since there is no discharge from the site to the storm drain, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0108 for the subject facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes. Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface water becomes necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this office and obtain Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) prior to discharging any groundwater from the site to surface waters.
