**TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—CAGNEY RANCH—ALISO RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT PROJECT, 8700 SESNON BLVD., GRANADA HILLS, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-9012)**

In our letter dated February 6, 2006, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0111, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater From Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have received and reviewed your June 25, 2008 letter, requesting termination of your coverage under the General Permit. The letter indicated that you have completed the culvert construction project, and no groundwater was encountered during the project construction.

On April 21, 2008, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of wastewater from the site to the Aliso Creek. Since there is no discharge from the subject site, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0111, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004, for the subject project is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

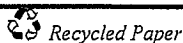
Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain waste discharge requirements.
